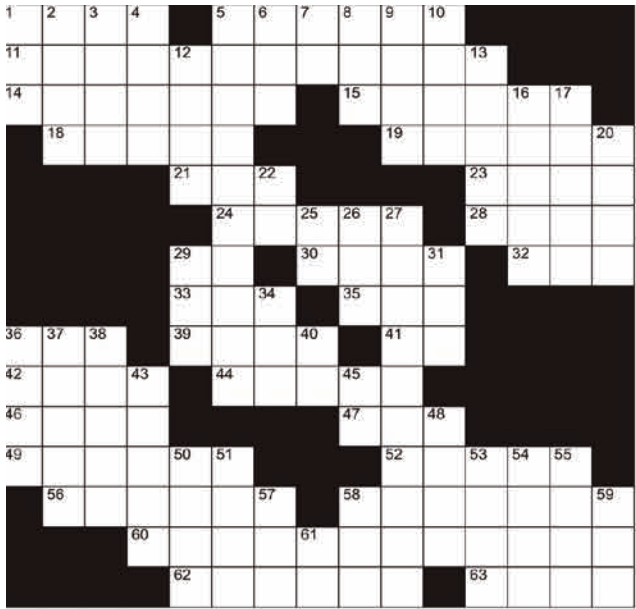
ORDINANCE NO. 2020-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MONTICELLO, FLORIDA BY AMENDING CHAPTER 54, DIVISION 2, SECTION 54-152(c)(2)(m) TO CREATE A PROCESS OF CONTINUING AN ALLOWABLE SPECIAL EXCEPTION USE OF PROFESSIONAL OFFICES AND LIMITED, RESIDENTIALLY-COMPATIBLE BUSINESSES IN THE MIXED-USE OFFICE/RESIDENTIAL OVERLAY DISTRICT OF THE R-1 ZONING DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR LEGAL EFFECT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, SCRIVNER'S ERRORS, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
