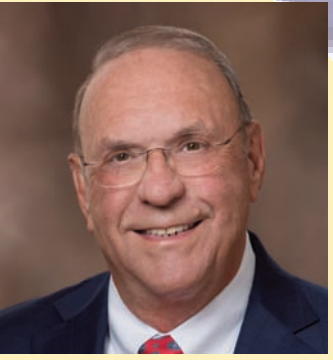

Lt. Laslie was a member of the 2nd Battalion, 4th Regiment of the Third Marine Division. He graduated from the University of Georgia ROTC program and was placed on active duty on June 25, 1967. In March of 1968, he was deployed to Vietnam. On May 25, 1968, Lt. Laslie was killed in combat when a sniper's bullet struck him in the head. He was 23 years old. The regiment he was a part of suffered an 80 percent casualty rate.
