Golf Carts in the City

The City of Monticello wants to remind you of some rules and restrictions for operating Golf Carts.

Golf Carts are not permitted to drive on U.S. Highway 19, also known as North Jefferson Street and South Jefferson Street within the city limits; or on U.S. Highway 90, also known as West Washington Street and East Washington Street in the city limits.

The only exception to this is to cross these streets at the below listed locations:

S Jefferson St. W Washington St. East Washington St. Palmer Mill Road Mulberry Street Cherry Olive Street Water Street Hickory Street Willow Street/Felix Street

East Washington St. Cherry Street Waukeenah Street Hill Street MLK/Rhodes Street

Golf Carts that are not equipped with headlights, brake lights, lighted turn signals and windshields may ONLY be operated during daylight hours.

No one under the age of 16 is permitted to drive a Golf Cart in the city.

Please refer to Chapter 86, Article VII of the Monticello Code of Ordinances for a complete list of rules and restrictions. ALL Golf Carts MUST be registered with City Hall.

The cost of such abatement will constitute a special assessment lien against the property on which the nuisance is located.
Such special assessment lien shall be coequal with the lien of

all state, county, district, and municipal taxes and superior in dignity to mortgages and all other liens, irrespective of the date of the recording of the municipal lien or the date of the recording of any mortgage or any other lien on real property. A failure to pay said lien, even such lien upon homestead property, may result in a loss of title to your property."
